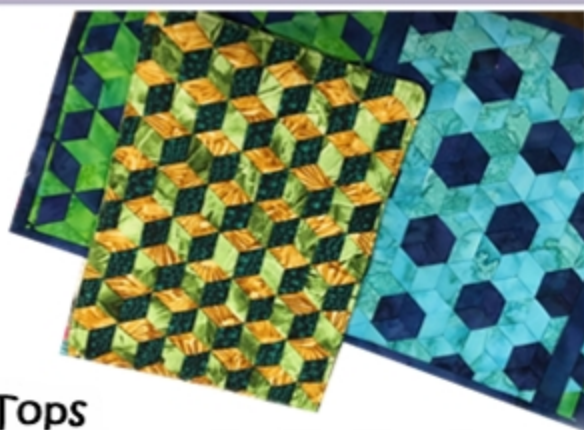


## Workshops: Sandy M.
