Rules:

1. The block must be an original design. No kits or patterns by others will be accepted.
2. All items submitted must be constructed to include three layers (top, batting, back) and be quilted and bound.
3. The hanging size of the item must be not less than 10" x 10" (total perimeter of 40") and not larger than 16" x 16" (total perimeter of 64").
4. Each submission must have a door or gate somewhere in its design.
5. Each submission must have a button somewhere in its design.
6. Embellishments are accepted and encouraged.
6. Each submission must have a label which includes the owners name and the name of the submission attached to its back. The labels must not be visible to viewers.

QUILT REGISTRATION SPECIAL NOTES

1. Due to space limitations we will be unable to accept any quilt larger than 96 inches across.
2. Members will be limited to displaying three quilts each. This does not include the quilt challenge. Please indicate on the registration form your first, second or third choice for display. We cannot guarantee that all quilts will be displayed but we will try our very best to display as many as possible.
3. If you have a quilt for sale it will be appropriately marked. Prospective buyers will be asked to speak to the ladies at the Ticket table who will give them the owner's telephone number only. All sale negotiations are then up to the owner and the prospective buyer.
4. Please ensure that your quilt is wearing a proper label which includes your name, the quilt's name and any other information you consider important. The label should be securely attached to the back of the quilt (not pinned).
