Good news is that neither sleeves nor pillow cases are required. Labels must be sewn on the back with your name, address and phone number. It is ok if your quilt has been in a different show, but can't have been shown at a Sagebrush quilt show.

If you have a quilt for sale, it must be indicated and the Quilt Show committee will provide your contact information to the potential seller who you will negotiate with.
