## Guild night mini workshop - March 26th - Doffy B

For the project bag you will need to bring:

- 7" zipper measure the zipper from pull tab to metal end not from the fabric ends
- 1 1/2 strip of fabric wof 2 1/2" wide folded and ironed as for a binding (one strip is just enough, the extra half of a strip leaves room for error)
- Sewing machine and matching thread
- Strong machine needle we will be sewing through 2 layers of plastic plus many layers of fabric
- Scissors

Iron 7 seams
Rip out 3 rows
Haul 2 bolts
Thread machine
Pick up pins
Squint at block
Pace in front of
design wall
Caffeinate
