Please make this quilt using a white, off white or cream background AND red for the hearts. The red can be red, pink, patterned or ???. We just want to keep all the unfinished 12.5" (12" finished) blocks dancing together in unison.

Bring your completed block to any guild meeting or the Community Sewing Day at Katja's and Geri B. will organize them and create beautiful quilts to donate.

## Have a Heart - Give a Heart

The Community Quilt committee offers this fast and easy block for you to share your talents. If you could make one or a stack of these blocks and bring them to Guild or to a Community Quilt day, we can make them into quilts.

You can make the heart all in one colour, or mix it up with 4 colours.

The block top is made with 2-6 1/2 " squares with 2-2 1/2" squares acting as connector corners.

The bottom is made with a 6 ½" ½ square triangle. Layer 2 6 7/8" pieces, draw line down the center and stitch ¼ " from the line – cut along the line.

Sew the 2 tops and 2 bottoms together, then join all four and MAGIC - YOU HAVE A HEART!
