

Have a Heart - Give a Heart

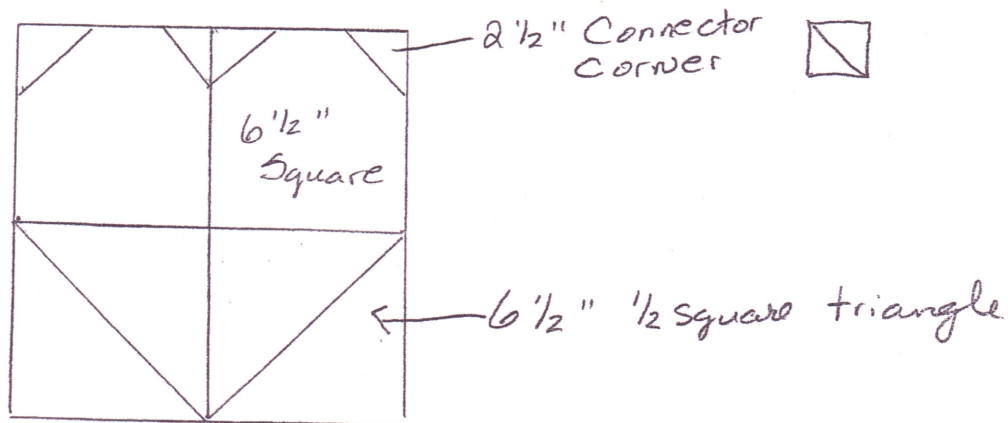
The Community Quilt committee offers this fast and easy block for you to share your talents. If you could make one or a stack of these blocks and bring them to Guild or to a Community Quilt day, we can make them into quilts.

You can make the heart all in one colour, or mix it up with 4 colours.

The block top is made with 2 - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares with 2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares acting as connector corners.

The bottom is made with a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " $\frac{1}{2}$ square triangle. Layer 2 $6\frac{7}{8}$ " pieces, draw line down the center and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the line - cut along the line.

Sew the 2 tops and 2 bottoms together, then join all four and MAGIC - YOU HAVE A HEART!
