Instructed by Marnie Freeman

Cost: \$35

Supply list

1 - Panel or feature fabric

0.7meter of each of the following:

Light fabric (or medium) for window casing

Dark fabric for window casing

Contrast fabric for sashing

Additional fabric for Border (optional)

This yardage is enough for a panel that is approximately 35" x 40"

(Approximately 1 square meter)

Panel print, Storey book panel, Printed theme blocks, collection of coordinated blocks
