SCRAPPY DOG AND CAT BEDS

The rescue shelters love our pillow beds.

To make a pillow bed divide the pillow into 3 sections and sew 2 strips length ways down the pillow, stopping 3 inches from the top. Then fill each section three quarters with scraps. You want the pillow to be filled but not too firm. When done filling, sew across the top. I shake the pillow out, so the scraps fill all the spaces and are evenly distributed.

If you have larger scraps you can divide the pillow in half and fill each side, then finish the same way. If you have larger pieces of material you can make a square by folding the material in half, sew each side and down the middle. When half filled sew across the pillow before stuffing the last section.

Thank you for making the beds, I can collect them and hand them out. We now have three rescue centers that use the beds, Angel's animal rescue, Tuff Star dog rescue and the Maple Ridge SPCA.
