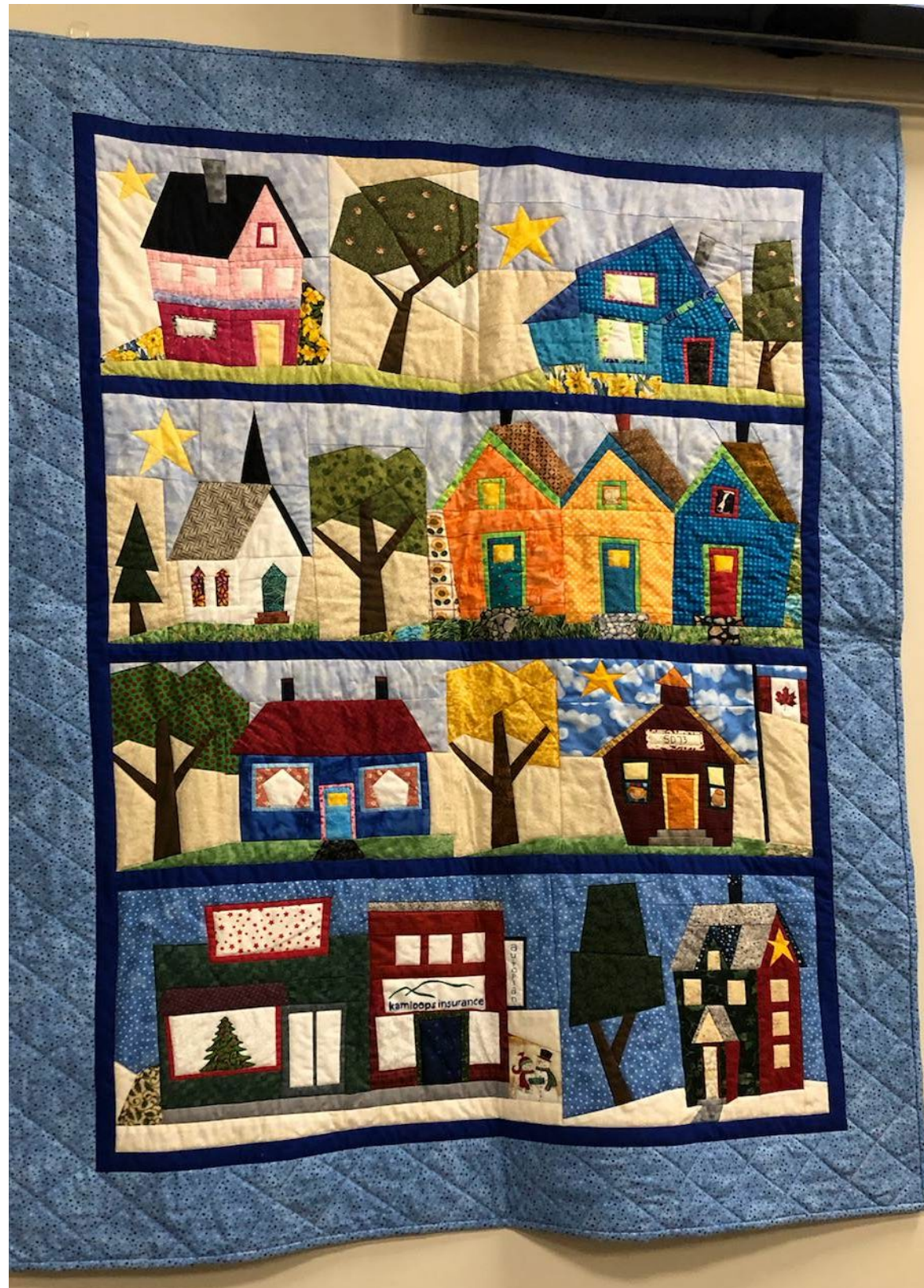

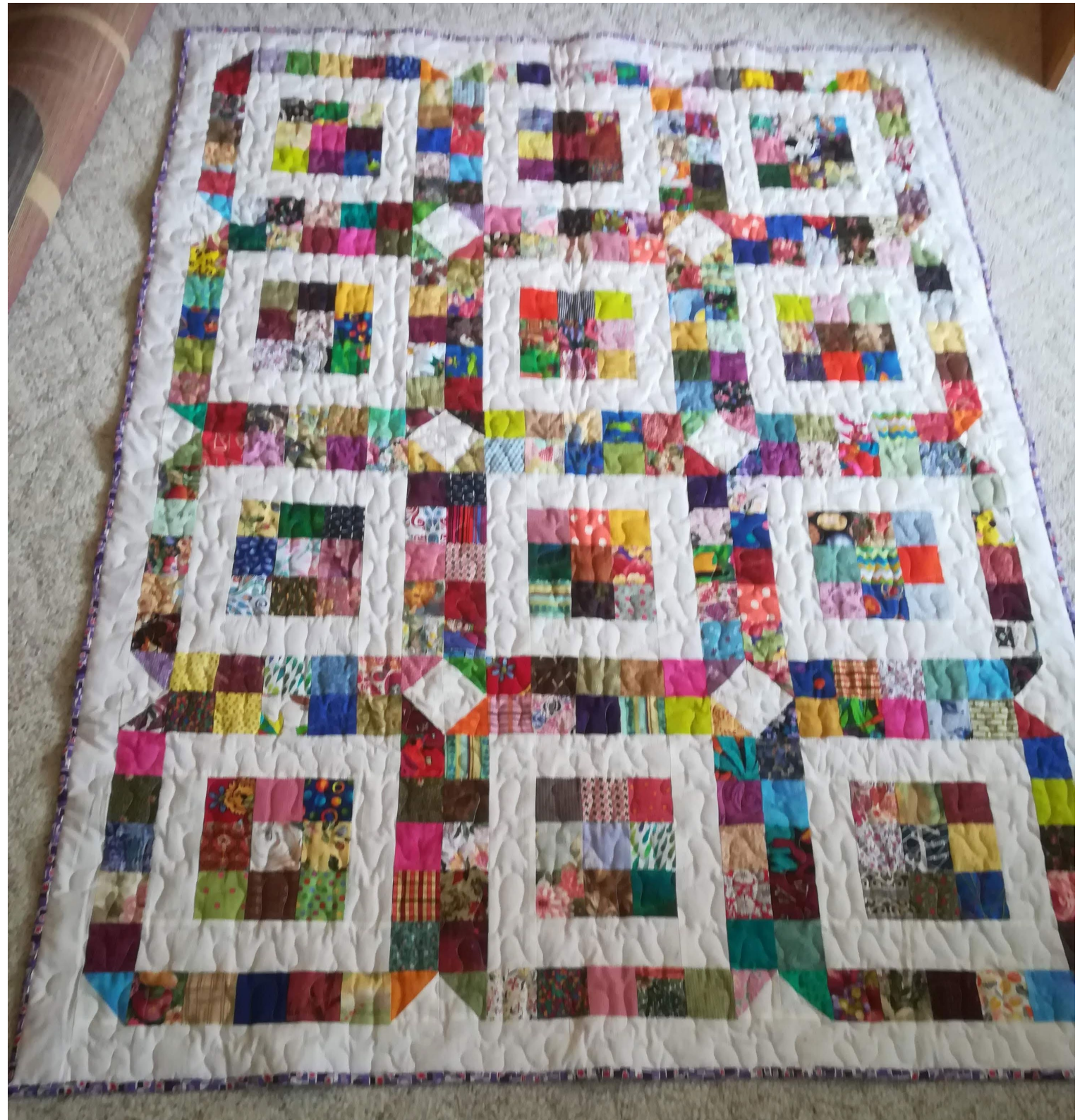

- Each block or row is also sold separately which can be finished as a mini quilt.
- This quilt is 84" x 108" and the fabrics are 1895 Hoffman Batik Watercolors.
- Its not quilted yet as Andrea is still working up the courage to do that.
