Picnic Quilt Pat M

- This is a perfect quilt to keep in the car for picnics.
- Pat started this quilt during a spring trip to Arizona over 7 years ago. She is on a mission to finish a quilt before she starts another one.
- The Size is 39 x 54 inches
- It is sticked in the ditch and has colourful watermelons on the back.
- Pieced and quilted by Pat



Pumpkin Patch Panel Pat M

- Pat found this panel and matching fabric a few (many) years ago. She sewed the top during a winter trip to Arizona five plus years ago and she finally finished this month.
- The Size is 40 x 56 inches
- The quilt will go in the pile to be gifted later.
- Pieced and quilted by Pat



Poultry in Motion Panel

- This panel & fabric was left over from a kit to make a different quilt that Katja had may years ago.
- Pat used the solid red from her stash
- The Size is 40 x 52 inches
- The quilt was gifted to a local fellow who goes above and beyond in our neighbourhood
- All the extra fabric was out of Pat's stash.
- Pieced and quilted by Pat



Locked Down Mug Rugs Pat M

- While watching different YouTube videos on quilting, Pat came across this one that uses freezer paper and Elmer's School Glue as the applique technique.
- This mug rug was made by combining fussy cutting the pattern and blocks.
 It used up a few more scraps.

Bare Branches Pat M


- Pat saw this pattern on-line at Annie's Quilting designed by Bev Getschel.

- With so many blocks, you really need to focus getting the block layout right. Only had to unsew about 9 times.
- The Size is 68 x 85 inches
- Another quilt for the pile to be gifted at sometime in the future
- Pieced by Pat and soon to be quilted by Bernadine Libreiro of Sooke, BC



- Appliqué kites and balloons with a kite fabric background.
- All fabrics from Julie's stash.
- It was pieced and quilted by Julie
- Measures 40 x 50 inches



- A simple front. The blue fabric is bumble bees and the backing is a fire truck on fleece that has been in Julie's stash for 'I don't know how many years'
- It was pieced and quilted by Julie
- Measures 40 x 50 inches



- This one has funky cats in the blue squares and simple piecing
- It was pieced and quilted by Julie

- Mystery sampler quilt pattern from pg 50-53 of Fat Quarter Quilts by M'Liss Rae Hawley
- Using leftover fabrics from "Feather your Nest Kit" especially to feature "blessings of Joy" border print and other leftover coordinating fabrics.
- Joy liked this pattern because it let's you Design /Layout of blocks. She added the 1" lime green sashing border and final outer 4" border of dark blue to the pattern and had enough leftover pieces to make a scrap binding. Backing is green flannel.
- Size is 65.5 x 74.5 inches
- Machine pieced by Joy G
- Lori Dewalt did the computerized quilting pattern "Joyful" edge to edge digital panto with Prickley Pear Glide thread



Community Quilt – Strip Quilt

- Quilting was done by Sam Albert's Quilting Curve Studio (Grand Forks, BC).







Embroidery Sampler


Vicki G

- Vicki put this in an exhibit titled "A Touch of Orange" which was shown at the White Rock Library for the month of February 2021. It is done on hand-dyed linen and the green border is Dupioni silk.
- It is 16" x 24". Vicki loved doing the embroidery.

- This is a hand appliqued quilt called "Hello Spring".

- Guilds may borrow one or both of the exhibits.
- Size is 8" x 8"



My Funky Fish Vicki G

- 'My Funky Fish' are framed pieced that Vicki made last year when she dislocated her shoulder and a month later, cut the tendon in her thumb and was unable to do much stitching.
- These were simple fused and appliqued pieces that were machine blanket stitched.
- Vicki donated one to the Sotheby's auction at Sun Peaks.
 Another was given to a friend and the third she kept for herself.
- These were super easy and fun to do, pre-cut and prepared for fusing from Applique Elementz and each measures 13" x 13"
