# BLOCK LOTTO - Lorraine B

Continuing to play with blocks featuring 2 1/2 by 6 1/2 inch pieces, I have chosen the quick and simple "Four Part Strip Block" from Quilter's Cache. Pattern and photo of example blocks are attached. Please use GREENS for your blocks. Please place darkest fabric in the center.

If you use three jelly roll strips you will be able to cut 2 or 3 extra 6 1/2 inch units. Bring these units as well for a bonus entry in draw and they can be assembled into a scrappy quilt. Happy piecing!
