- Judy N- thank you to everyone who donated 2.5 inch binding strips. A grand total of 7,242 inches, or 603.5 ft, enough binding for 27 quilts. This binding is being collected on behalf of Quilt Canada for quilts for Residential School Survivors.
- Cheryl D- Community Projects
  - When your community quilt is ready for binding, you will be sent an email letting you know. Cheryl will leave your quilt on the table at the side of the room with your name on it. In addition, when you have finished a quilt top, and it's ready for quilting, leave it on the table with your name on it for Cheryl to pickup. This should streamline the drop off and pickup process for Cheryl.
  - Thank you to everyone who participated in the past two guild "garage sale" type events of donated quilting material and items. To date \$1600 has been raised to go towards batting and backing for community quilts.
  - O Heather and staff, at Heather's Fabric Shelf, offered to have a table in her store to try to sell some of the items. Heather did a daily video to let her customer know what was on the sale table, and to promote the cause. She offered to match the amount donated by customers. \$157 was raised, so Heather gave the guild a \$157 gift certificate!
  - Another Fabric Palooza will be on May 26. Bring your own big bag! Half yard pieces will be approximately \$5- and one-yard pieces will be around \$10.
