The November block is a 12 inch "New Album Block" from Delawarequilts.com. Please use bright colours with black background.

Program- Leanne S

Guest speaker is Marnie Freeman- Memory Quilts by Marnie.

Marnie is a long-time member of our guild. In 2017 she started her business making T-Shirt Memory quilt. In fact, her very first memory quilt was made in 2017 for her sister.

Take aways from her presentation:

-any fabrics with a preprinted logo can be used; cottons, polyester, nylon, sport jerseys, clothing

- likes to use Minkie or Fireside on the back

-does not use interfacing; it is too expensive and time consuming; some claim it is required to keep the fabric from stretching; however, that is not the case. In addition, using interfacing changes the feel of the quilt and makes it stiffer. Andrea Funk, from Too Cool T-Shirt Quilts, also believes iron on interfacing is not necessary to stiffen the quilts and without it the quilts are soft.

-a throw size T-shirt memory quilt cost \$600-\$800. More information on her website

-there are lots of hidden costs with her business, such as maintaining website, accountant fees, paying herself a living wage

-when sewing T-shirt fabric use a straight stitch needle plate or start ½ inch inside the edge and then go back and finish sewing the to close it up. This prevents the fabric from catching

-borders are optional but nice when you long arm your quilt

-sewing with women's clothing you will need to use interfacing to keep the shape of the item

-Marnie teaches two classes each year, one in the fall and one in the spring, through the City of Kamloops program guide;

-Carousel quilt pattern works well when working with women's clothing, such as linen. Avoid diagonal cuts, cuts on the bias do not work well

-general rule all block sizes should be divisible by 4. (8, 12, 16, 20); bigger designs make the whole process go quicker

-a set of template ruler can be rented for \$20 cash

-center your logo before cutting it out; sometimes you need to join two rulers together to cut the right cut (20 x 16) or cut the bigger size first and then cut it down, late if needed

-the more sizes you can cut the easier it is to put the quilt together later

-to determine the size of your quilt, first add up the total square inches and then take the square root

-polyester batting is best when working with jersey and different weight of fabric; there is no shrinkage

-when adding borders, measure each side and make sure they are the same length or they will be wavy;



Add the side borders and then top and bottom borders

-nylon thread in the bobbin when sewing on the binding

-Directional fabric is not taken into consideration

-15-20 shirts is a good number to work with
