### **Budget- Andrea**

The Sagebrush Quilters Guild Working Budget for 2024-2025 was emailed out to members this morning.

Vicki M, guild treasurer, reported our Bank Balance is \$20,838.78 and that includes Joyce's Legacy fund of \$5,989.20

Discussion of the working budget:

- Andrea explained that the rent may be raised in January 2025.
- Under Office expenses there is a new charge of \$5 per month bank fee. This is because we now we deal with Royal Bank.
- Last year we had a relatively small Program budget, but that has been increased this year \$1290.00 to cover the cost of guest presenters and program expenses.
- There was an inquiry as to our projected revenue for this year. It will be our total membership by \$40 fee = \$2800. We also received some donations from Cancer Quilt recipients, but we can not count on that.
- Workshop: There was some initial planning to share some costs with the Merrit Quilt Guild to bring a nationally renowned quilt teacher, Terry Rowlands, to teach a workshop for our guild. However, the Merritt guild has decided not to do that, so if someone from our guild is interested in pursuing this it could be something we look at for next year. Perhaps a Workshop committee could be set up to take this on?

# Sagebrush Quilters' Guild Meeting Minutes-October 14, 2024

- Library will have a budget of \$410 this year to cover the cost of new books and upgrading our online search engine to TinyCat
- Community projects budget has had an increase this year due to the rising cost of material (especially batting) to \$4000. Additional needed funds will come from Joyce's legacy fund
- The Total Working Budget for 2024/25 will be \$8,270.
- Next year the guild will need to increase membership fees. That decision will be made at the AGM in June.

A motion was made to accept the budget as presented by Julie O. Seconded by Doreen C. All in favour show of hands; passed.

• A recommendation was made from the floor to have a \$2000 contingency fund to cover the initial cost of having another quilt show.
