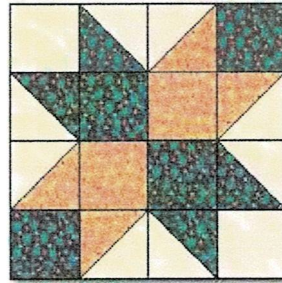


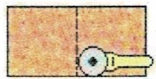

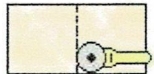
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



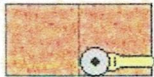
Start by marking and cutting your Color 1 3-1/2" x 7" strip into two 3-1/2" squares...



Then cut your Color 2 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares...



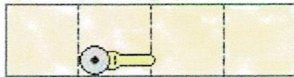
Then cut your Color 3 3-1/2" x 7" strip into two 3-1/2" squares...



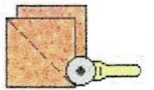
Now cut your Color 1 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip into two 3-7/8" squares...



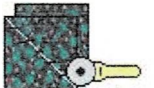
Cut your Color 2 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip into two 3-7/8" squares...



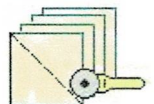
And lastly your Color 3 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" gets cut into four 3-7/8" squares...



Then cut your Color 1 3-7/8" squares on the diagonal...



Also Color 2 3-7/8" squares on the diagonal...



...and Color 3 3-7/8" squares on the diagonal...[on to Page 2!](#)

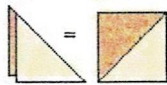

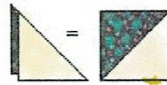

Sunlight and Shadows - Page 2

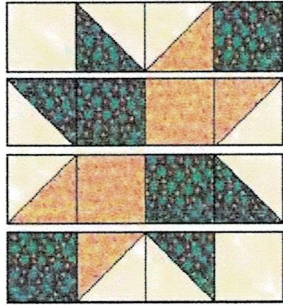


Starting with a Color 1 and Color 3 triangle, stack them right sides together with edges aligned. Sew in a 1/4" seam. Press the seam allowances towards the darker fabric. Make FOUR of these. Trim to measure 3-1/2" if needed...



Then combine Color 2 and Color 3 in the same manner, making four of those as well...

And now piece your block ...following the diagram for placement of the squares...press row seams in alternating directions.... Good Job !!



There's one more Block to your credit! :o)
